1. Fort Ethan Allen, Colchester.  
Military base
2. Location of some of the mills and factories doing vital wartime production.
3. State capital, Montpelier.  
Center of civil defense and war mobilization.
4. Ten air raid warning centers,  
(Every town in Vermont could be warned in ten minutes by telephone.)
5. Brattleboro Retreat  
Mental hospital staffed by conscientious objectors.
6. Berlin, Vermont, debates changing its name because it is the same as the capital of Germany. The town decides to keep its name, feeling that there should be one free Berlin in the world.
7. South Burlington Airport,  
Flying school for Army Air Corps pilots
8. Copper mines at Ely reopened.
