GEORGE the second by the Grace of God of Great Brittain, France and Ireland, King Defender of the faith & c—

Know ye that We are Settling a New Plantation within our Province of New Hampshire with the advice of our Trusty and well beloved Benning Wentworth, Esquire, our Governour & Commander in Chief of our said Province of New Hampshire in America.

The Governour does Grant in Equal Shares to those whose names are Entered on this Grant that Tract of Land within our Province of New Hampshire.

The Tract of Land is Six miles square as follows: Beginning at the Hemlock Tree marked W: Six miles due North of a White Oak Tree standing on the Boundary line of the Province of Massachusetts Bay.

The Grantees shall plant five acres of Land. This land is incorporated into a Township by the Name of
